I don't think the answer would be to fire a city manager, but to find out where the pressure came from that more than likely guided this person and I am sure many others to make hasty decisions or in some cases simply look the other way.

I would suggest that a full audit of the Arena Project and all development (to include the [REDACTED] Building) within the newly appointed arena district would be in order. Further this should include where the Arena Line was first conceived/presented as a viable option to provide the Arena with LRT service, and the justification thereof. The questions begs to be answered, "who in their right mind agreed to develop an LRT line in Edmonton that is such a contrary element only as viewed comparing to any modern public transit system in the world?" I believe a audit alone will provide Edmontonians with a clear assessment of the circumstances surrounding the LRT disaster and I believe many other current projects that have in fact circumvented due process in their approval and development.

I am still waiting for the 5 locations study that was commissioned before the decision was made to locate the Katz Project in downtown Edmonton, and further the remediation study results I was promised before the project was underway.
